O R D E R

On December 8, 1982, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8568 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On February 7, 1986, Pendleton County Water District, Gas Division, ("Pendleton") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective March 1, 1986, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Pendleton's notice of February 7, 1986, set out certain revisions in rates which Pendleton proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$3,628 or 2.24 cents per Mcf.

(2) Transmission filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") an application for decreased rates to be effective January 1, 1986.

(3) Pendleton miscalculated the amount of its decrease per Mcf; it proposed a decrease of 2.18 cents per Mcf instead of 2.24 cents per Mcf. The correct amount, 2.24 cents, should be subtracted from Pendleton's base rates to calculate the revised rates.

(4) Pendleton's re-calculated adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8568 dated December 8, 1982, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after March 1, 1986.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


(1) The rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after March 1, 1986, in place of Pendleton's proposed rates included in its filing.

(2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order Pendleton shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
