
O R D E R


On October 9, 1986, the Commission established Administrative Case No. 308, An Inquiry Into Kentucky's Present And Future Electric Needs And The Alternatives For Meeting Those Needs. The objectives of the inquiry are to examine all reasonable planning options and determine which of them might be cost-effective in Kentucky and to develop a regulation that provides for the regular review of resource planning issues. Thus, Administrative Case 308 continues the initiative begun by the Commission when this case was established by an Order on September 28, 1982.

Because of the establishment of Administrative Case No. 308, the Commission finds that there is no longer a need to continue with Case No. 8666. It is therefore ORDERED that Case No. 8666 shall be closed.
