ORDER

On December 20, 1985, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9291 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On September 9, 1986, the court-appointed receiver of Martin Gas, Inc., ("Martin") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") effective September 1, 1986, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Martin's notice of September 9, 1986, set out certain revisions in rates which Martin proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$1,204 or 2.36 cents per Mcf.

- (2) Martin's wholesale cost of gas was decreased by Columbia effective September 1, 1986.
- (3) Martin's proposed rates were incorrect in that the monthly rate for usage over one McE did not include the adjustment for the decrease filed in Martin's notice of September 9, 1986. Also, the allowance of 5 percent for line loss was incorrectly added to the decrease instead of subtracted. The correct rates are reflected in the Appendix to this Order.
- (4) Martin should report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1986, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections to its customers.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- (1) The rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1986.
- (2) Within 30 days of this Order Martin shall report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1986, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections.
- (3) Within 30 days of the date of this Order Martin shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
