O R D E R

On February 20, 1986, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") submitted comments regarding the proposed Software Defined Network service ("SDN") of AT&T Communications ("AT&T"). SCB's concern is that SDN service can be used to complete calls within the LATA.

SCB has proposed that, should an Order be issued approving the SDN tariff, the Order stipulate the following: that the call control feature of SDN be programmed to permanently block unauthorized intraLATA calls.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that AT&T shall file with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order a response to SCB's comments indicating the feasibility of the proposal to block unauthorized calls within the SDN system.
