ORDER

On September 9, 1986, Hardin County Water District No. 1 ("Hardin County") filed Motions to continue the September 18 hearing and for an informal conference. Hardin County stated that it has been given insufficient time to respond to the staff report and was unable to properly prepare for the hearing. Comments were due in response to the staff report on September 12. The Commission finds that the Motion for continuance should be granted. The Commission will defer any action on the Motion for an informal conference until Hardin County furnishes the reasons for such meeting.

On Septemer 11, 1986, counsel representing the estate of Else Carroll, and Mildred Reed filed a Motion for limited intervention. The Commission will defer any action on this Motion pending an opportunity for Hardin County to respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Hardin County's Motion for a continuance be and it hereby is sustained. However, Hardin County should clarify within 10 days from the date of this Order its statement in the Motion that "The Water District has a contractual duty with the insurance carrier which will prevent the Water District from being able to fully present its case before the Commission."

2. Hardin County shall furnish within 10 days from the date of this Order additional support, including the reasons and proposed agenda, for its Motion for an informal conference.

3. Hardin County shall have an additional 20 days to provide written comments to the staff report attached to the August 29 Order.

Hardin County shall furnish any comments to the 4. September 11 Motion to Intervene within 10 days of the date of this Order.
