O R D E R

By its Order dated April 10, 1987, the Commission denied the motion of the Independent Telephone Group ("ITG") for an extension of time, until June 30, 1987, for its members to file responses to the Commission's Order of March 4, 1987. Therein, the Commission inadvertently failed to identify Lewisport Telephone Company ("Lewisport") and Logan Telephone Cooperative, Inc., ("Logan") as members of ITG to which the Order would be applicable.

The Commission hereby modifies its Order of April 10, 1987, to include Lewisport and Logan as members of the ITG and finds that they should comply with the provisions of said Order.

The Commission HEREBY ORDERS that Lewisport and Logan are required to comply with the Commission's Orders of March 4, 1987, and April 10, 1987, as are all other members of ITG.
