O R D E R

On February 4, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9642 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On August 6, 1987, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas had been increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective April 1, 1987.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:


(1) The rates proposed by Western Lewis to be effective April 1, 1987, have been superseded by subsequent rate changes for which Transmission has applied with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. Western Lewis' proposed rates will not be placed into effect and should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The rates proposed by Western Lewis be and they hereby are denied.
