O R D E R

On March 25, 1987, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc., ("AT&T") filed its motion requesting consolidation of the above-styled cases. As support for its motion AT&T cited the Commission's decision in Case No. 9678 and Case No. 9800 for General Telephone Company of the South.¹ In these cases, the Commission recognized consolidation as the most efficient method of addressing the issues presented in separate cases to adjust rates and to consider the effects of the new tax law.

The Commission, having considered the motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that AT&T's motion be and it hereby is
