O R D E R

On April 10, 1987, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc., filed an application for adjustment of rates to become effective for service rendered on and after May 1, 1987.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- (1) The proposed rates be and they hereby are suspended for 5 months on and after the 1st day of May, 1987.
- (2) All parties of record shall file within 2 weeks from the date of this Order comments pertaining to the issues in this matter.
- (3) Nothing contained herein shall limit the Commission's ability to render a decision on any or all aspects of the proposed rates prior to the end of the suspension period.
