ORDER

On October 13, 1987, Lexington-South Elkhorn Water District ("District") filed a Petition for Rehearing. The petition alleges that it has information which will indicate the level of subsidy anticipated by the Commission as it relates to extension of service to the District is reasonable. It seeks rehearing to offer evidence to support the terms of the contract between it and Kentucky-American Water Company.

The Commission stated in the Order of September 23, 1987, that it would consider modification to the contract which reflects a balancing of regional water supply and cost sharing. In an effort to achieve this balance, the Commission will grant rehearing to give the parties the opportunity to submit a mutually agreeable modification of Section 5 of the contract. This proposal should be filed with the Commission within 30 days and be

fully explained and documented. Upon receipt of this proposal, the Commission will determine the need for further investigation and hearings.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Rehearing is granted; and
- 2. The parties shall file a mutually agreeable modification of Section 5 of the contract within 30 days of this Order.
