O R D E R

On October 2, 1987, Kentucky CGSA, Inc. ("KY CGSA"), by counsel, filed a notice letter that it was constructing a new cellular tower cell site to serve Lexington, Kentucky, and the surrounding area. KY CGSA considered the construction an extension in the ordinary course of business pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(3), and that no formal Commission approval was required.

On review of the filing, the Commission finds that the proposed construction is significant enough to warrant prior approval pursuant to KRS 278.020. Accordingly, the Commission moves to treat the notice letter as an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity and establishes this case on its own Motion.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) KY CGSA's October 2 notice filing be and it hereby is treated as an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct additional facilities pursuant to KRS 278.020 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2).

(2) This case be and it hereby is established to consider the reasonableness of the application.
