O R D E R

On December 4, 1987, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., filed Second Revised Sheet No. 7-D of its Special Agency Service Tariff to allow it to use multiple tier pricing under its agency program.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and possible hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date of December 22, 1987.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of December 22, 1987.
2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
