O R D E R

On September 20, 1988, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a supplement to information filed in this case on September 7, 1988. Along with the supplemental response, South Central Bell filed a petition for confidential treatment, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7. As reason for its petition, South Central Bell states that (1) the information is not known outside South Central Bell, (2) the information is not disseminated within South Central Bell and is known only to employees with a business need to know and act upon the information, (3) South Central Bell preserves the confidentiality of the information through appropriate security measures in its offices, (4) disclosure of the information would cause competitive injury to South Central Bell through providing competitors with sensitive financial information, and (5) nondisclosure will not damage any public interest.

The Commission, having considered the petition and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that it should be granted, subject to the provisions of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.

Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED.
