In your July 29, 1988 letter of response to the inquiry into the status of this case dated July 19, 1988, you stated, by counsel, that "technical and tariff changes in the provision and billing of 800 and OUTWATS service has rendered such a decision [from the Decree Court concerning BellSouth's motion for a waiver from the Modified Final Judgment restrictions] moot." Please specifically describe the technical and tariff changes to which you refer.

2. Does AT&T have any agreement in Kentucky with local exchange companies to jointly provide billing of WATS and/or 800 service? If so, please describe.
