INTERIM ORDER

On December 20, 1985, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9318 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On August 10, 1988, Auxier Road Gas Company, Inc. ("Auxier"), notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas had been decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia"), effective September 1, 1988, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Auxier's notice of August 10, 1988 set out certain revisions in rates which Auxier proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier. The decrease in price from Columbia included an adjustment for a fixed charge recovery for contract reformation and take-or-pay costs from Columbia's suppliers which

have not been approved by the Commission. This adjustment understated the overall decrease in rates by 7.92 cents per Mcf. Therefore, the wholesale decrease in price from Columbia to Auxier is \$5,678 or 10.34 cents per Mcf.

(2) At such time when Columbia's fixed charge recovery for contract reformation and take-or-pay costs is approved, the Commission will issue an Order reflecting the revised rates.

(3) Auxier's wholesale cost of gas was decreased by Columbia effective September 1, 1988.

(4) Auxier's corrected adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 9318 dated December 20, 1985 is fair, just, and reasonable, in the public interest, and should be effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1988.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1988.

(2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Auxier shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
