O R D E R

On November 21, 1988, the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers ("KIUC") filed a motion to extend the current procedural schedule to allow the filing of its second round of discovery of Kentucky Utilities ("KU") on November 21, 1988 rather than the original due date of November 18, 1988. KIUC states that the delay was necessitated by problems caused by KU's failure to properly identify all documents sought by KIUC in its first round of discovery.

Based on the motion and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that good cause has been shown to grant KIUC's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that KIUC's motion to file its second round of discovery of KU on November 21, 1988 be and it hereby is granted.
