O R D E R

On January 14, 1988, Sandy Hook Water District ("Sandy Hook") filed a Motion to reinstate the Petition filed on November 18, 1986, wherein it sought Commission approval to issue securities, construct certain water facilities and increase water rates. The Commission entered an Order on September 18, 1987, approving certain water rates, but dismissing this case without prejudice in regard to construction and financing because Sandy Hook was unable to meet the requirements of Farmers Home Administration ("FmHA") within the 10-month time period required for rate cases.

Sandy Hook states it has now completed all FmHA requirements. Therefore, the Commission is of the opinion and FINDS that the Motion should be granted and this case should be reopened to consider the merits of the proposed construction and financing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion be and it hereby is granted and Case No. 9768 is reopened to consider the facts already in the record.
