ORDER

On October 2, 1987, Kentucky CGSA, Inc., ("Ky. CGSA") filed an application for authority to construct facilities, including a cellular communications tower, at a new cell site in Jessamine County, Kentucky. The new cell site will to serve Lexington, Kentucky, and the surrounding area. Ky. CGSA was requested to supply additional information by Order dated November 2, 1987. Its response was filed on November 20, 1987.

The Jessamine County Planning Board ("Planning Board") was formally notified of Ky. CGSA's application. The Planning Board was requested to provide comments by January 14, 1988. No response was filed by that date.

FINDINGS AND ORDER

The Commission having considered the application and evidence of record, and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that Ky. CGSA should be granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct its facilities at the proposed site in Jessamine County. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ky. CGSA be and it hereby is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct the proposed cellular communications facilities at the Jessamine County site.
