O R D E R

On February 29, 1988, North Shelby Water Company filed its tariffs for non-recurring charges to become effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 1988.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The proposed tariffs be and they hereby are suspended for 5 months on and after the 1st day of April, 1988.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
