O R D E R

On March 7, 1988, Southern Madison Water District ("District") filed a proposed amendment to its regulations for water main extensions that require contributions of extension footage by both the District and the customers of interest in the extension. By Order entered May 6, 1988, District was requested to file information to more specifically and properly define its proposed amendment. May 30, 1988 was set as the date the District should file this information.

Mr. Ray Curry, District's superintendent, by letter filed June 7, 1988, requested an extension of the filing date to June 30, 1988. Later, by letter filed July 18, 1988, Mr. Curry requested withdrawal of the matter from the Commission's docket.

The Commission, after consideration of the District's request and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

1. District's request for withdrawal of this matter from the Commission's docket should be granted.
2. Dismissal of this matter should be without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the instant case be dismissed without prejudice.
