On May 2, 1988, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T"), filed an application to reduce rates for Wide Area Telecommunication Service ("WATS"), AT&T Reach-Out Kentucky Service, Software Defined Network Service, AT&T Megacom 800 Service, and AT&T 800 Ready Line Service. The application was amended on May 17, 1988. US Sprint Communications Company ("US Sprint") is an intervenor in this proceeding.

A hearing in this matter will not be scheduled on motion of the Commission, but the Commission will consider any request for a hearing filed by a party.
