ORDER

On May 2, 1988, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T") filed an application for adjustment of rates by Petition. On May 16, 1988, US Sprint Communications Company The Motion was ("US Sprint") filed a Motion for intervention. granted on May 17, 1988. Also, on May 17, 1988, AT&T filed a Motion to amend its application. The Motion was granted on June Also, on June 1, 1988, the Commission granted AT&T 1. 1988. interim authority to implement rates as filed in its amended application, pending further investigation. Subsequently, on July 29, 1988, the Commission entered a schedule of procedure to guide On its own Motion, the Commission did not the investigation. schedule a public hearing, but specified August 24, 1988, as the date by which US Sprint could request a public hearing. US Sprint did not request a public hearing.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that (1) a public hearing in this investigation is not necessary, since no party has requested a public hearing, and (2) AT&T's rates should be approved on a permanent basis as filed in its amended application,

effective on the date of this Order, since AT&T has fully complied with requirements established in Case No. 9889. AT&T should file revised tariff pages to implement this decision within 30 days from the date of this Order.

Accordingly, the above findings are HEREBY ORDERED.
