ORDER

On June 3, 1988, East Pendleton County Water District ("East Pendleton") filed an application for Commission approval to adjust its water rates pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076. East Pendleton proposes to place the rates into effect immediately.

The Commission finds that:

- (1) East Pendleton gave insufficient notice to the Commission in violation of KRS 278.180. The proposed rates should be noticed to be effective on July 3, 1988, which is 30 days from receipt of the application.
- (2) Pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The proposed rates be and they hereby are suspended for 5 months on and after the 3rd day of July, 1988.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
