ORDER

On September 16, 1988, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell"), filed a Motion for Full Intervention in this proceeding.

South Central Bell claims that the tariff proposal of United States Transmission Systems ("USTS") could lead to the completion of intraLATA calls by USTS. Since USTS intends to offer operator services to subscribers served through Feature Group D access arrangements, the approval of USTS' operator service tariff may have no effect on the amount of unauthorized intraLATA traffic. However, since validation of LEC calling cards is an issue in this proceeding, the participation of South Central Bell is likely to assist the Commission.

The . Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Motion be and it hereby is granted.
