O R D E R

The Commission's Orders of September 29, 1988 and August 19, 1989 in this investigation deferred certain issues to a formal conference for technical review and recommendations. These issues are:

- 1. The implementation of the non-premium access discount in the \mathtt{ULAS}^1 allocation plan.
- 2. The definition of measurement of terminating switched access minutes of use.
- 3. ULAS reporting procedures and formats. That is, the need for out-of-period adjustments to carrier ULAS usage reports and the cycle of carrier ULAS reports and ULAS charges determination.

In each instance, the Commission provided specific suggestions to be considered at the formal conference. Also, the Commission advised the parties that other issues related to ULAS tariff requirements and implementation guidelines could be added to the formal conference agenda as appropriate. Finally, in order

to facilitate discussion at the formal conference, the Commission required South Central Bell Telephone Company to file ULAS tariff changes consistent with its decisions and technical suggestions. The tariff filing was made on September 13, 1989.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Any party that wishes to add issues to the formal conference agenda shall file a motion with the Commission no later than December 20, 1989.
- 2. A formal conference is hereby scheduled on January 22, 1990 at 10:00 a.m., E.S.T., in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.
