O R D E R

This matter arising upon petition of South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") filed August 8, 1989, and supplemented on August 31, 1989 pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, for confidential protection of SCB's response to the Attorney General's Data Request No. 2; and it appearing to the Commission as follows:

The Attorney General's Data Request No. 2 seeks any market studies that SCB has concerning the effect of intraLATA competition upon local exchange carrier toll traffic and revenues in other jurisdictions. These market studies contain suggested market strategies to counter loss of intraLATA toll which competitors of SCB could use in devising their own market strategies. Disclosure of this information is thus likely to cause substantial harm to SCB's competitive position and give its competitors an unfair advantage. Therefore, the information should be protected from public disclosure.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The petition by SCB for confidential protection of the information furnished in response to the Attorney General's Data Request No. 2, which SCB has petitioned be withheld from public disclosure, shall be held and retained by this Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection.

2. South Central Bell shall, within 10 days of this Order, file an edited copy of the market studies with the confidential material obscured from inclusion in the public record and furnish copies to all parties of record.
