ORDER

This matter arising upon petition of US Sprint Communications Company ("US Sprint"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, for confidential protection of certain information filed with this Commission pursuant to its Order of May 1, 1989 and it appearing to the Commission as follows:

On May 1, 1989, this Commission entered an Order directing each party to this action to furnish certain information relating to their operations. Included among the information to be furnished was the identity of the WATS resellers to whom each of the parties provided service. US Sprint has petitioned this Commission to protect such information as confidential on the grounds that it is not known outside the company and its public disclosure would cause the company substantial competitive injury. The petition, however, does not state how disclosure of the information will cause competitive injury to the company.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The petition by US Sprint for confidential protection of the information furnished in response to Items 1(a) and 1(c) of

the Commission's May 1, 1989 Order shall be held in abeyance to allow US Sprint to supplement its petition with a statement setting forth with specificity its reasons for believing that disclosure of the information sought to be protected will cause the Company substantial competitive injury.

2. If such statement is not filed within 10 days of the date of this Order, the petition for confidentiality shall, without further orders herein, be denied.
