ORDER

On March 23, 1989, the Commission, on its own motion, established this proceeding to address the WATS resellers issues from the Administrative Case No. 311¹ proceeding. In that Order, the Commission stated that it had notified all utilities providing long-distance services, including all WATS resellers, that the Administrative Case No. 311 rehearing would address the issue of whether WATS resellers should have to participate in the ULAS allocation plan. However, the Commission, subsequent to the Administrative Case No. 311 rehearing, decided to initiate this separate proceeding.

On May 1, 1989, the Commission ordered all parties to respond to information requests. WATS resellers were specifically ordered to respond to several delineated questions. To date, the following WATS resellers have not responded and have failed to comply with the Commission Order:

Kentucky Telephone Corporation
LDD, Inc.

Wright Businesses, Inc.
d/b/a Long Distance Management

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS AND COMPELS the WATS resellers listed above to respond within 20 days of the date of this Order to the questions outlined herein.

The parties designated herein shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

- 1. Provide a copy of the Commission Order granting the company a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.
- 2. (a) Identify all services marketed to end users in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation.
- (b) For each service identified above, provide a brief description of the nature of the service and end-to-end service configuration.

- (c) For each service identified above, provide a schematic diagram showing end-to-end service configuration. Label each segment of the service configuration.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is marketed for interstate use, intrastate use, or combined jurisdictional use.
- (e) For each service identified above that is marketed for intrastate use, indicate whether it is marketed for interLATA use, intraLATA use, or statewide use.
- 3. Identify all local exchange carriers from which the company purchases access services for use in originating or terminating intrastate jurisdictional traffic.
- 4. (a) Identify all originating switched access services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate intrastate intraLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- 5. (a) Identify all terminating switched access services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each

service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.

- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to terminate intrastate intraLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (e) For each service identified above, provide associated intrastate minutes of use for the most recent available 12 months.
- 6. (a) Identify all special access services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate intraLATA jurisdictional traffic.

- 7. (a) Identify all other access services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate intraLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- 8. Provide the company's carrier acronym and carrier identification code as designated by BellCore.
- 9. Provide the company's most recent composite or feature group specific percent interstate usage factor(s).
- 10. (a) Identify all services purchased from interLATA carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the interLATA carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.

- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate intraLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- 11. (a) Identify all local exchange services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.
- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate intraLATA interexchange jurisdictional traffic.
- 12. (a) Identify all intraLATA interexchange services purchased from local exchange carriers in Kentucky. List each service separately according to its tariff designation and name the local exchange carrier(s) from which it is purchased.
- (b) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate interstate jurisdictional traffic.
- (c) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate interLATA jurisdictional traffic.

- (d) For each service identified above, indicate whether it is used to originate or terminate intrastate intraLATA interexchange traffic.
- 13. (a) Indicate whether the company owns or operates any telecommunications transmission facilities in Kentucky and describe the nature of any such transmission facilities, other than transmission facilities leased from interLATA and local exchange carriers.
- (b) Indicate whether the company has any affiliation with another company that owns or operates telecommunications transmission facilities in Kentucky or any other jurisdiction, describe the nature of any such affiliation, and describe the nature of any such transmission facilities, other than transmission facilities leased from interLATA and local exchange carriers.
