ORDER

On February 4, 1987, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9642 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On January 23, 1989, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas will be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective February 1, 1989, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Western Lewis's notice of January 23, 1989 set out certain revisions in rates which Western Lewis proposed to place

into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$2,250 or 4.2 cents per Mcf. In setting out the rates to be effective, Western Lewis used incorrect rates to adjust for the decrease.

- (2) Transmission applied with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for a decrease with an effective date of February 1, 1989.
- (3) Western Lewis's corrected adjustments in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 9642 dated February 4, 1987 are fair, just, and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after February 1, 1989.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- (1) The rates in the Appendix to this Order, attached and incorporated hereto, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved effective with gas supplied on and after February 1, 1989.
- (2) Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Western Lewis shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
