ORDER

On August 7, 1989, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed a letter agreement setting forth the terms of a settlement with the Commission's Staff. The Settlement Agreement encompasses both the issues pending in this Commission-initiated investigation and those raised by LG&E in its appeals to the Franklin Circuit Court from the decisions in Case Nos. 9934^1 and $10064.^2$ LG&E has requested that based on the achievement of this Settlement Agreement the Commission suspend LG&E's obligation to file testimony in this proceeding on August 14, 1989.

Based on a review of the Settlement Agreement and being advised, the Commission finds good cause to modify its June 23, 1989 Order to suspend LG&E's obligation to file testimony on August 14, 1989.
