O R D E R

On February 24, 1989, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") filed a motion for confidential treatment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, requesting confidential treatment of certain responses to the Commission's information request dated February 10, 1989. The items are portions of the attachment to 14(b) and pages 1-7 of the attachment to 17(a).

In support of its motion, SCB states that this information is competitively significant, that the assumptions and analysis used in the data is unique to SCB, and that the information is not known outside of SCB nor widely disseminated within SCB.

On April 10, 1989, SCB filed a motion for confidential treatment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, requesting the Commission treat as confidential SCB's responses to oral requests from the deposition of March 28, 1989, specifically Items 6 through 11. In support of its motion, SCB states that the information is competitively significant, that it is not known outside of SCB nor widely disseminated within SCB, and that there would be no damage to any public interest in disclosure. SCB

requests that only the Commission and its Staff review the information contained in Items 6 through 10.


On March 23, 1989, MCI Telecommunications Corporation ("MCI") filed a motion for confidential treatment, requesting that the original deposition of James Shallenberg signed by him on March 2, 1989 be protected from public disclosure pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7. In support of its motion MCI states that the deposition was taken pursuant to a protective agreement between MCI and SCB and should be maintained as confidential and proprietary.


The Commission, having reviewed the motions and being sufficiently advised, is of the opinion and finds that SCB's motions and MCI's motion should be granted.
