ORDER

On March 20, 1989, Johnson County Gas Company, Inc. ("Johnson County") filed its response to the Order of the Commission dated March 15, 1989. In order to determine what adjustments may be appropriate, the Commission needs supporting documentation and testimony on all matters raised in Johnson's County's response.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Johnson County shall file the original and 10 copies of testimony and supporting exhibits, with a copy to all parties of record, clearly setting forth and quantifying each and every adjustment in order to reflect its position on the revenue requirements of Johnson County under current operations by April 19, 1989. Include with the testimony the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. This testimony should include the detailed computation of all adjustments and the annual revenue requirements proposed by Johnson County. All positions and adjustments proposed by Johnson County should be adequately documented and supported. If the information cannot be provided by this date, you should submit a motion for an extension

of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.
