O R D E R

This matter arising upon motion of the intervenor, Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Utility and Rate Intervention Division ("Attorney General"), filed August 10, 1989 to supplement the record in this case with an inspection report from the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet, Division of Water, and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

Subsequent to the hearing in this case, an inspector for the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet, Division of Water, has issued a report in which he states that on August 2, 1989 he made an inspection of the treatment plant operated by Great Oaks Sanitation Company, Inc. ("Great Oaks"). The report contains comments concerning the presence of backwash and mud-tank pumps which are relevant to the issues in these proceedings, and which may conflict with testimony and evidence presented at the hearing.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The inspection report from the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Cabinet, attached as an exhibit to the motion by the Attorney General, is hereby made a part of the record herein for the limited purpose of addressing the state or condition of the sewage treatment plant operated by Great Oaks and the presence or absence of the backwash pump and mud-tank pumps at the plant.



The other parties to this proceeding shall be permitted to supplement the record by filing with this Commission, within 10 working days of the date of this Order, such documents, statements, or other evidence relevant to the state or condition of the plant and to the presence or absence of backwash pumps and mud-tank pumps.
