O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Delaplain Disposal Company ("Delaplain") shall file the original and 10 copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested is due no later than June 16, 1989. If the information cannot be provided by this date, a motion for an extension of time must be submitted stating the reason for the delay and the date by which the information can be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

1. Provide a breakdown of the total revenue that the proposed rates will produce on an annual basis.


2. Provide a list of all commercial and/or industrial customers that Delaplain has added to its system since December 31, 1988. Also, provide the capacity level that each of the above customers has operated at for 1989 on a monthly basis.

3. Provide detailed cost justification for the proposed \$2500 tap fee?

4. On page 8 of the 1988 annual report under operating revenue, tap fees were listed totaling \$11,500. Provide a breakdown of this \$11,500 amount separating the totals collected from residential customers versus commercial/industrial customers.
