ORDER

On March 20, 1989, Contel of Kentucky, Inc. ("Contel") notified the Commission by letter of its intention to continue a promotional period to waive certain service connection charges related to its Centrex offering. The promotional period would begin March 12, 1989 and be in effect for 6 months.

The letter was filed in accordance with Contel's General Exchange Tariff, Section 10, Sixth Revised Sheet 2, which requires that notice of promotions be given to the Public Service Commission.

After review of the record and being sufficiently advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. In this case Contel has adhered to the filed tariff and the promotional period for the waiver of certain service connection charges relating to Centrex service should be approved.

2. In the future, Contel should file notice with the Commission prior to instituting a promotional period.

3. Contel should furnish the Commission the results of each promotional program within 30 days of the conclusion of the promotional period.

Accordingly, the above findings are HEREBY ORDERED. Done at Frankfort, Kentucky, this 24th day of April, 1989.
