ORDER

This matter arising upon motion for reconsideration of Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("Cincinnati Bell") filed on December 4, 1989, the Commission finds that reconsideration should be granted. The Commission has reviewed Cincinnati Bell's arguments concerning the use of the cost allocation procedures adopted by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). The Commission notes that a decision on adoption of the FCC Cost Allocation System is pending in Administrative Case No. 321.¹ The Commission is particularly concerned about the FCC allocation of costs between regulated and unregulated services.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Commission will grant the request for reconsideration. A schedule for discovery will be issued in January 1990.
