O R D E R

On July 24, 1989, Americall Systems of Louisville ("Americall") filed a proposed tariff with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") making numerous revisions to its rates and rules of service which it proposes to place into effect August 23, 1989.

After reviewing the proposed tariff, the Commission finds that additional investigation will be necessary which cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date. Accordingly, the filing must be suspended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Americall's proposed tariff be and it is hereby suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date through January 23, 1990.
2. The tariff hereby suspended is the entire P.S.C. No. 2 filed July 24, 1989.
3. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
