ORDER

On October 13, 1989, Evansville MSA Limited Partnership ("Evansville") applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a new cell facility for its domestic public cellular radio telecommunications service in the Owensboro, Kentucky, Metropolitan Statistical Area (the "Application"). The facility includes a 198-foot tower which Evansville proposes to build on a parcel of land surrounded by 12 houses and one mobile home. According to the scale on the map furnished with the Application, the nearest residence would be 125 feet from the tower; the nearest property line would be 75 feet from the tower.

The Commission finds that the issue of the safety of erecting a 198-foot tower in the midst of a residential area is paramount and that it is desirable to elicit the comments of the residents and property owners located within 500 feet of the proposed tower. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Evansville shall give notice of the Application in writing to each and every resident whose dwelling lies within 500 feet of the proposed tower site of the Application.

2. Evansville shall give notice of the Application in writing to each and every property owner who has property which lies within 500 feet of the proposed tower site of the Application.

3. The notice distributed as required above shall be that contained in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated as if fully set out herein. The map showing the location of the proposed tower shall be attached to this notice.

4. Evansville shall complete the written notification described above on or before December 10, 1989, and within seven days after completion of the notification, Evansville shall file an affidavit with the Commission verifying full compliance with this Order and listing the name and address of each resident and property owner who received the notice, the manner in which notice was delivered, the date notice was delivered, and attaching a true copy of the written notice given to the residents and property owners.
