ORDER

On October 27, 1989, Fleming-Mason Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation filed an application seeking approval of a revision to its electric power tariff to become effective for service rendered on and after December 1, 1989.

After reviewing the proposed tariff, the Commission finds that further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The proposed tariff be and hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date, through May 1, 1990.

(2) Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
