ORDER

On November 21, 1989, International Telecharge, Inc. filed with the Commission a tariff which offers a new service entitled "Bulk Transmission Service".

1. The proposed tariff of International Telecharge, Inc. entitled "Bulk Transmission Service," be and it hereby is suspended for a period of 5 months from December 21, 1989 through May 21, 1990.

2. Nothing contained in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
