## ORDER

On June 23, 1990, LDDS of Kentucky, Inc.<sup>1</sup> and LDDS of Indiana, Inc.<sup>2</sup> (jointly "LDDS") filed a motion to adopt a settlement proposal. On July 17, 1989, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T") filed a response in opposition to the motion. On November 7, 1989, LDDS filed a motion to schedule a status conference to discuss the settlement proposal and the status of the case.

As indicated, only AT&T has filed comments on LDDS's settlement proposal. Although other parties have had ample time to file comments, the Commission has never explicitly scheduled a comment cycle. Accordingly, the Commission hereby invites comment on LDDS' settlement proposal.

Also, in the opinion of the Commission, a conference is not necessary to explain the terms of the settlement proposal at this time.
