- 1. The motion of Tesinc to intervene is granted. Tesinc shall not provide any utility service as defined by KRS 278.010 without prior authorization from this Commission.
- 2. Tesinc shall be entitled to the full rights of a party at the hearing and shall be served with the Commission's Orders, but shall not be served with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, and all other documents submitted by parties and shall not be certified as a party for the purpose of receiving service of any petitions for rehearing or petition for judicial review.
