On May 8, 1990, the Commission denied the application for rehearing of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), but attempted to clarify that portion of our March 27, 1990 Order which concerned Green River Steel Corporation's ("GRS") right to terminate service. Upon reviewing the language of our latter Order, the Commission finds that our attempt at clarification did not resolve the ambiguity of our former Order.

The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that ordering paragraph two of the May 8, 1990 Order is stricken and replaced with the following:

2. So long as the present contract between KU and GRS for electric service under the LCI-TOD rate schedule remains in effect, GRS may terminate electric service at the end of the fixed contract period by providing written notice of termination to KU at least 90 days prior to the expiration of the initial 5-year term or the annual renewal period. Nothing herein or in the Commission's Order of March 27, 1990, however, shall be construed as altering the fixed term of contract expressly provided for in the LCI-TOD rate schedule.
