## ORDER

On January 22, 1990, U.S. Operators, Inc. ("USOI") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. By Order dated March 5, 1990, the Commission required USOI to respond to certain information requests. On April 25, 1990, without having responded to the March 5, 1990 Order, USOI filed a motion to withdraw its application. In supporting its motion, USOI states that it has determined to withdraw its application for a certificate and that no party will be prejudiced by such action.

The Commission, having considered the application, its previous Orders, the motion to withdraw, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS AND COMPELS that USOI provide a response to the following information request contained in the March 5, 1990 Order:

> Has USOI ever provided and/or collected any money from the public for the provision of intrastate telecommunications services in Kentucky? If so, explain in detail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. USOI's motion to withdraw its application shall be held in abeyance pending a response to the above-stated question.

2. USOI shall file its response, signed by an officer under oath, within 20 days from the date of this Order.
