ORDER

This matter arises upon the July 16, 1990 tariff filing by Brights Propane Service, Inc. ("Brights") of a proposed tariff to establish rates, charges and conditions of service for initial operations. This filing was made pursuant to the Commission's April 23, 1990 Order in Case No. 90-091 exerting jurisdiction over Brights' propane service in Boyle County, Kentucky.

Brights' proposed an effective date of August 1, 1990 for its tariff; however, pursuant to KRS 278.180 and 807 KAR 5:011, Section 6(3), at least 30 days notice to the Commission is required before any tariff can become effective. Therefore, the actual effective date of the tariff should be August 15, 1990. Further, it appears to this Commission that pursuant to KRS 278.190 further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the actual effective date.

This Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised,
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The proposed rates are hereby suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date through January 14, 1991.

2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
