On November 5, 1990, MCI Telecommunications Corporation ("MCI") filed a motion for leave to depose Thomas Madden of Theodore Barry and Associates at the Commission's offices pursuant to KRS 278.340. MCI contends that depositions will enable it to fully explore the independent auditor's analysis and conclusions.

The Commission having considered the motion and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY GRANTS depositions rights to MCI. The requested deposition of Thomas Madden shall occur at the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky, at a mutually convenient time to be arranged by MCI. Further, the depositions shall be taken in accordance with the Rules of Civil Procedure.
