O R D E R

On January 7, 1991, Jessamine County Water District No. 1 ("Jessamine No. 1") filed an entry of appearance and notice of opposition to any water service in its territory. The Commission will treat this filing as a motion for full intervention in these proceedings, and it appearing to the Commission that Jessamine No. 1 has a special interest in these proceedings which is not otherwise adequately represented and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist this Commission in fully considering the matters without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The motion of Jessamine No. 1 to intervene is granted.
2. Jessamine No. 1 shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. Should Jessamine No. 1 file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, Jessamine No. 1 shall also serve a copy of said documents to all other parties of record.
