## <u>O R D E R</u>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1(11), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. A public hearing shall be held on August 14, 1991, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, to examine the application of the fuel adjustment clause of Fleming-Mason Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Fleming-Mason") from November 1, 1990 to April 30, 1991. If no interested party files with the Commission by August 12, 1991 written notice of its intent to attend this hearing, this public hearing shall be cancelled.

2. Fleming-Mason shall file with the Commission on or before July 26, 1991 an affidavit attesting to its compliance or noncompliance with the requirements of 807 KAR 5:056.

3. Fleming-Mason shall publish the following notice not less than 7 days nor more than 21 days prior to the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in its service areas or in a trade publication or newsletter going to all customers:

If no notices of intent to attend are received by that date, this hearing will be cancelled.
