ORDER

On August 5, 1991, the Commission approved the tariff filing of South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") introducing service options associated with open network architecture on a permanent basis except that portion of the tariff which proposed an exchange access premium charge was denied. On March 5, 1991, the Commission had approved on a interim basis the proposed tariff except for the exchange access premium charge.

On August 9, 1991, South Central Bell filed a motion for reconsideration of the Commission's Order requesting that the Commission reconsider the order to file tariff sheets reflecting the Commission's final decision. In support of its motion, South Central Bell states that these tariff sheets were filed on April 4, 1991 with a March 6, 1991 effective date pursuant to the Commission's interim decision in this matter. The tariffs filed by South Central Bell on April 4, 1991 comply with the Commission's Order of August 5, 1991. Therefore, South Central

Bell would like to avoid the administrative burden of refiling a lengthy tariff.

The Commission, having considered South Central Bell's motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the motion be granted and that South Central Bell be relieved from again filing its open network architecture tariff. Ordering paragraph 3 of the Commission's August 5, 1991 Order is hereby vacated.
