O R D E R


On July 26, 1991, the Commission received a letter from Representative Jack L. Coleman expressing his concern that the cellular tower proposed to be built by Kentucky RSA #4 Cellular General Partnership ("Kentucky RSA #4") will be too close to adjoining residences and could pose a safety hazard if the tower should fall. His letter further states that the proposed tower will be located approximately 280 feet from the Holloway residence and 385 feet from the Stewart residence. However, the Commission notes that in Kentucky RSA #4's application, Exhibit J, a map of the proposed cellular site indicates that the tower will be approximately 500 feet from the Holloway residence and over 600 feet from the Stewart residence. Due to these discrepancies, the Commission finds that Kentucky RSA #4 should conduct a further survey of the proposed site and submit a statement, from the firm that prepared Exhibit J, setting forth the distances from the center of the base of the proposed tower to the Holloway and

Stewart residences. If the survey indicates that revisions are needed to Exhibit J, an amended exhibit should be filed. In addition, Kentucky RSA #4 should place a marker at the center of the base of the proposed tower so that adjacent residences can readily determine its location.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, within 7 days of the date of this Order, Kentucky RSA #4 shall: 1) provide a statement and, if necessary, an amended Exhibit J setting forth the distances from the center of the base of the proposed tower to the Holloway and Stewart residences; and 2) place a marker at the center of the base of the proposed tower.
